1 Introduction

This document is part of the Combitech certification and evaluation regulations for use with EUCC, defined by its implementing act, *Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2024/482 of 31.1.2024*. EUCC and Combitech's certification and evaluation regulations are below called the Combitech EUCC Certification and Evaluation Scheme or just the Scheme.

This document is part of a series of documents that provide a description of aspects of the Scheme and procedures applied under it. This document is of value to all participants under the Scheme, i.e., to anyone concerned with the development, procurement, or accreditation of Information and Communications Technology (ICT) products for which security is a consideration, as well as those already involved with the Scheme, e.g., certifiers, evaluators, customers, contractors, and security consultants.

1.1 Purpose

The purpose of this document is to describe how the Combitech trademarks and certificates, may be used and referred to by other parties.

General information about the Scheme is published in *Combitech EUCC Certification and Evaluation Scheme*, CAB-240701-164858-361, Combitech AB.

1.2 Terminology

The following terms are used to specify requirements:

SHALL Within normative text, "SHALL" indicates "requirements strictly to be followed in order to conform to the document and from which no deviation is permitted." (ISO/IEC).

SHOULD Within normative text, "SHOULD" indicates "that among several possibilities one is recommended as particularly suitable, without mentioning or excluding others, or that a certain course of action is preferred but not necessarily required." (ISO/IEC) The CC interprets 'not necessarily required' to mean that the choice of another possibility requires a justification of why the preferred option was not chosen.

MAY Within normative text, "MAY" indicates "a course of action permissible within the limits of the document." (ISO/IEC).

CAN Within normative text, "CAN" indicates "statements of possibility and capability, whether material, physical or causal." (ISO/IEC).

2 General

The name of the Certification Body, "Combitech Certification Center", and the Combitech logotype also used as Combitech Certification Mark, illustrated below, are trademarks and under the exclusive control of Combitech.

The color shall be: RGB 0,65,130 – Hex #004182 – CMYK 100,78,20,0 – PMS 7687 C.

All certificates issued by Combitech will carry the Combitech logotype and the name of the Certification Body. The conditions for use of these documents are stated below.

2.1 EUCC Certification Mark

A product whose certificate is recognized according to EUCC may carry the EUCC certification mark, under the conditions given in the documents: *Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2024/482 of 31.1.2024* and *Annexes to the Commission Implementing Regulation*.

This mark confirms that a Common Criteria evaluation was conducted and certified in conformance with the requirements of the EUCC. Upon receipt of a Common Criteria certificate under mutual recognition, Sponsors and Developers may use the mark in conjunction with advertising, marketing, and sale of the product for which the certificate is issued.

These conditions are further detailed in Article 11 of the *Commission Implementing Regulation* and the Annex IX of the *Annexes to the Commission Implementing Regulation*.

2.2 SWEDAC Accreditation Symbol

Certificates and certification reports issued by Combitech, within its accreditation, will carry the Swedish Board for Accreditation and Conformity Assessment, SWEDAC, accreditation symbol.

The conditions for uses of the SWEDAC accreditation symbol are stated in STAFS 2020:1 *Styrelsen för ackreditering och teknisk kontrolls föreskrifter och allmänna råd om ackreditering* (In Swedish) available on SWEDAC's website (www.swedac.se).

The accreditation symbol may only be used together with the name, symbol or logo-type of the accredited body.

3 Combitech Documents and Certification Mark

3.1 Conditions for the Use of Combitech Certificates

A certificate issued by Combitech may be used by Sponsors and Developers in documentation or marketing material for the certified product as stated below.

It is preferable to reproduce the entire certificate instead of using the Combitech logotype for documenting or marketing a product certified under the Scheme. The certificate SHALL be reproduced in an accurate and readable form.

The product SHALL be exactly the same product and version that is covered by the certificate.

The context and presentation SHALL make it obvious that the certificate is related to the certified product only – no confusion with products or product versions not certified under the Scheme shall be possible.

The Sponsors and Developers SHALL refrain from using withdrawn certificates for marketing purposes.

Under no circumstances may the certificate be used in any context that may be perceived as offensive. This includes slander of individuals or other entities.

3.2 Conditions for the Use of Combitech Certification Mark

A certificate of conformity issued by Combitech also includes the permission to use the Combitech Certification Mark according to the recommendations in this document. It may be used by Sponsors and Developers in documentation or marketing material for the certified product but it is recommended that consideration should be given to the use of the entire certificate of conformity which would be more precise.

The conditions for the use of the Combitech Certification Mark are correspondent to the use of certificates described above.

It is not permitted to use the Combitech Certification Mark to indicate on the product that it is certified since it could be confused with national or other marks.

When a digital Certification Mark is needed it SHALL be ordered from Combitech by email, info@combitech.com.

4 Misuse of Combitech Documents and Trademark

If a certificate is withdrawn, all use of the certificate or mark of conformity, as described in this document. SHALL stop immediately. Combitech will not be held liable for any damage or cost to other parties resulting from the withdrawal.

4.1 Misuse of the Combitech Certification Mark

Combitech will monitor and take any legal actions necessary to prevent the use of the Combitech Certification Mark, in conjunction with EUCC Certification Mark and/or SWEDAC Accreditation Symbol, in conflict with the conditions described in this document.
